17 Meet Workers

17.1 Guidelines

- Meet worker list is due on July 22, 2007 with the meet entries.
- Meet workers are drawn from each team proportionate to the number of entrants in the meet.
- Each worker shall work a minimum of a complete session; no session splitting shall be allowed.
- A meet worker coordinator or park district representative from each team shall be responsible for ensuring the availability of workers at each worker shift according to the worker assignment determined from final calculated worker estimates.

18 Awards

Awards will be given to the top sixteen (16) finishers in each event.

19 Post Meet Events

- Immediately after the last event, all swimmers, coaches, and participants will be asked to clear the pool area.
- Final results and awards presentations will be conducted in the Team Areas.
- Awards will be distributed after each team's area has been completely cleaned up.

20 Worker Sign-In Procedures

Each team must have a City Coordinator.

Responsibilities of City Coordinator:

- provide workers for City Meet
- sign in all their workers at the Worker Sign In Table
- provide replacement workers when worker doesn't show up

Sign-In Procedures:

- 1. City Coordinator will sit at the sign-in table. There will be a section of the sign-in tables reserved for each team.
- 2. Worker badges will be provided by the NPDSC.
- 3. The City Coordinator will distribute badges for their team and take attendance.

4. If there is a no-show, the announcer will make an announcement prior to the meet beginning. If the job is not filled quickly, the Park District Representative and City Coordinator for the team are responsible for finding a replacement.

Note that team area monitors are additional jobs that must be staffed by each team. These are not part of the jobs assigned by the NPDSC City Committee because every team must fill such a job.

Same as dual meets except 15-18 events will be Friday evening.

24 Facility

The pool is a 25-yard, 8 lane facility. Timing system is Daktronics with button backup. The meet will be computerized using the Hy-Tek Commlink II (see section 25). The

depth at the starting blocks is 13ft. and is 4ft. at the turn end. The starting blocks conform to IHSA standards. There are 6in. gold metal non-turbulent lane lines.

25 <u>Time Recording</u>

All ages –2 timers per lane, one plunger, and active touch pads. Primary: touch pad, Secondary: plunger, Tertiary: watches.

26 Meet Rules

All National High School Rules shall be in force except where NPDSC Officials Clinic Summer 2007 rules amend them. The following specific meet rules shall apply for this meet only.

- No more than five (5) coaches per team shall be allowed on deck at any one time during the course of the meet. Coaches shall be NPDSC-certified. (ASEP-certified and Background check on file with NPD office) Also, all coaches must stay in coaching bench area while on pool deck.
- Any and all disputes from the moment entries are received and merged for the meet shall be under the jurisdiction of the Meet Referee or the Meet Director if the Meet Referee is unavailable.
- Only personal audio devices with earphones will be allowed in the team areas. Boom-boxes, etc. will not be permitted.

27 <u>Warm-Up Designation.</u>

See warm-up schedules in the meet packet and posted on the walls in the pool, and bullpen. Time and lane assignments will be made after entries are processed. Warm-up designations will be included in the meet packet provided to the coaches at the start of the meet.

28 <u>Results</u>

One copy of the final results will be provided on 3.5" diskette to each participating team. PDF results will be posted on NPDSC website, <u>http://napervillepdsc.tripod.com/champs/</u>

29 Admission and Heat Sheets

- Admission is free.
- Cost of heat sheets will be \$3.00

30 <u>Concessions</u>

A wide variety of food concessions will be available throughout the meet in a (yet to be determined) concession area.

31 <u>Safety Requirements</u>

Swimmers will not be allowed in the water unless a coach from their team is on deck to supervise. All other NPDSC safety rules requirements shall be followed.

32 Miscellaneous

32.1 Marshalling

At least one marshal, who reports to and receives instructions from the meet referee and/or the meet director, shall be on deck during the entire warm-up session. Marshals shall have the authority to remove from the pool any swimmer whose coach is not supervising them and any person not authorized to be on the deck.

If a spectator or participate is unruly, the Marshall will report to the Meet Director. The Meet Director and Aquatics Director will decide how to deal with the situation. The Aquatics Director has the right to eject a spectator or participant from the facility.

32.2 Meet Packet

Each coaching staff shall be provided a meet packet the first day of the meet. The meet packet will include warm up designations as well as heat sheets for the coaching staff of the team.

32.3 Warm Up Designation Sheet

Each team will receive their warm-up designation sheet in the meet packet.

32.4 Cool Down Pool

The diving well is only open during the 15 -18 session.

The diving well only be used under the supervision of an on-duty lifeguard. Each team's coaching staff is expected to supervise the diving well when one or more of their swimmers is using the well.

33 <u>Team Areas</u>

- Each team is required to provide supervision of their designated team area.
- Each team area will be in the field house.
- Each team is responsible for leaving their team area clean after the meet
- Team areas will be designated. NO USING TAPE, ROPE, BALLOONS, etc TO MARK INDIVIDUAL TEAM AREAS.

34 General Notes

- Only swimmers, meet officials, workers and NPDSC-approved coaches are allowed on deck.
- Coach's meet packets will be available prior to the start of warm ups at the admission table or from the meet director
- No running, playing catch, throwing objects, etc., is allowed in the school building.
- Hats are not allowed to be worn in the school building.
- Any swimmer found outside of designated meet areas of operation will be asked to leave the meet. (Team Area, Deck, Pool, Viewing Stands, Concession Area, Entryways to facility.)

35 Spectator Area

• Spectators may not save seats.

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- Spectators may not bring or set up folding chairs (metal, cloth or otherwise) towels, or swimmer paraphernalia in the spectator area.
- Swimmers may not stay in the spectator area.

36 <u>Practice Schedule</u>

Location: Naperville Central High School Pool Dates: July 23,24,25 and 26

Each team gets a 40 minute practice block to acclimate the swimmers to the big pool.

Please be courteous and get your swimmers out of the pool in a timely fashion so the next team can have their full 40 minutes.
